MOST POPULAR SCHOLARSHIPS

Camp Crew: \$1,500 for junior summer, \$2,500 for senior summer

Student Fusion: \$1,500 for junior summer, \$2,500 for senior summer

Alumni Encouragement: \$500

Alumni Dependent: \$1,000 upon attending as a dependent of a Word of Life alumnus

Student Leadership: \$3,000 if selected for our student leadership team

Academic: Award amount is dependent on a 3.0 final high school GPA and SAT or ACT scores

Early Confirmation: Students who get accepted and pay a \$250 confirmation fee by a certain deadline will receive the coordinating award credited to their account

Church Matching: Up to a \$1,000 match of what a church will send as a scholarship to a student

FAFSA: We do accept the FAFSA as part of a student's financial aid
